FINDINGS OF FACT

4. The employer's workers compensation insurance carriers during the CT period were Pacific Employers and Federal Insurance/Chubb.

Both cases were resolved by Stipulations with Request for Award which was approved on October 30, 2006.

5. Applicant filed a Petition to Reopen on November 13, 2006.

6. Based on the medical reports of the AME, Dr. Roger Sohn, dated February 14, 2017, there is no new and further disability.


The Petition to Reopen is denied.


PETITION TO REOPEN:
